
What are your favorite hobbies/leisure activity?



THE ONE WHERE WE SEE WHAT'S COOKING Snow Day Cinnamon Rolls

There are few things I enjoy more than being told to stay home when it's snowing outside! Cinnamon Rolls are usually my first order of business on a good snow day. These are really simple to make without a huge hands on time commitment. I hope you try them and Happy Snow Days!

Prep 20 min Cook 20 m Ready In 1 h 30 m Makes 1 dozen

Ingredients

Dough

1 egg

¾ cup milk
¼ cup butter, softened
3¼ cups all-purpose flour
divided 2¼ c + 1 cup 1 (.25
ounce) package yeast
or 2¼ tsp (active dry yeast) 1/4
cup white sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup water



Filling

¼ cup brown sugar, packed ¼ white sugar 1½ tsp ground cinnamon ¼ cup butter, softened ¼ cup raisins (optional)

Frosting

3 oz cream cheese ¼ C butter 1 C powdered sugar

Directions

Heat the milk in a measuring cup in the microwave for 1 min. Mix in butter; stir until melted. Let cool until lukewarm. (If you put the butter in when it's not too soft it cools the milk down faster.)

In a large mixing bow (kitchenaid use the paddle attachment), combine 2 1/4 cup flour, yeast, sugar and salt; mix well. Add water, egg and the milk mixture; beat well.

Add the remaining flour, 1/2 cup at a time, stirring well after each addition. When the dough has just pulled together, switch out the paddle for the dough hook and run at a 2 for 5 minutes until you have a nice smooth ball of dough (or if making by hand - turn it out onto a lightly floured surface and knead until smooth, about 5 minutes.) Cover the dough with a damp cloth (or wet paper towel) and let rest for 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, in a small bowl, mix together white and brown sugars, cinnamon, and softened butter.

Roll out dough into a 12x9 inch rectangle. Spread dough with filling mixture leaving the top long edge free from filling (this will make pinching the edges together easier after you roll it up). Sprinkle with raisins if desired. Roll up dough and pinch seam to seal. Cut into 12 equal size rolls and place cut side up in a lightly greased 9x13" pan.

Cover with lightly greased plastic wrap and let rise until doubled, about 30 minutes. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (190 degrees C).

Bake in the preheated oven for 20 minutes, or until browned. While baking prepare your the icing.

Soften cream cheese and butter in a bowl in the microwave. Stir in powdered sugar until there are no lumps.

Let cinnamon rolls cool for 5-10 minutes and then spread icing on. Enjoy!!
